Field Trips

Official field trip forms must be completed, signed and returned to the student's teacher at the beginning of the school year. As field trips are scheduled, you will be notified of arrangements. Telephone calls from parents cannot be accepted as a form of permission to attend a field trip. All field trips shall be related to the course of study and have educational value. School personnel will provide notice that certain violations of District/Crabbe Elementary Schools behavior rules may result in a student not being able to participate in an extracurricular trip. Students who have been suspended, expelled, or assigned to an alternative classroom may not be eligible to participate in field trips. Students may not be denied the trip because of inability to pay.

Text Books and Library Books

Students are responsible to the school for the proper care of textbooks and library books and must pay for lost or damaged books. Students are required to pay fines for damaged textbooks in accordance to the amount of damage. In cases where the damage is so extensive as to render the book unusable, the full price will be collected since it will no longer be in use. Each student shall return all textbooks and library books when leaving the school, or at the end of the school year.

Parent Teacher Organization (PTO)

Our PTO works to bring a closer relationship between home and the school so parents and teachers may cooperate in the education of the children. Meetings are held throughout the school year and parents are welcome to attend. Volunteers are always needed for special activities such as fundraisers, Santa's Workshop, Book Fairs, and field trips. We are proud of our active PTO and urge you and all family members to join as soon as possible. Membership dues are \$3.00, and are accepted throughout the year.

Parking

In order to maintain a traffic safety program that is really effective, your cooperation will be needed. Our goal is safety for your children, not convenience and timesaving for parents. You can help us promote our safety program by observing the following regulations.

1. Stop at the curb when dropping off or picking up students. Students who exit vehicles stopped in the middle of the street or driveway are in danger of being hit by other traffic.
2. Have students enter or exit vehicles by the curbside doors only.
3. Please use Central Ave. entrance.
